Our City has just developed a Downtown Main Street Organization. They are limited in funds and with great plans for our downtown area. Our City is also new to Keep America Beautiful since becoming an affiliate of Keep MS Beautiful in 2007. This opportunity to apply for this particular grant is a great opportunity to assist and help jump start our Main Street area in continuing to beautify our City.

We are currently working to develop committees that will assist in each neighborhood clean-up. This will aid in awareness to help promote our City wide clean-up efforts, which is held every year from April 1-15. I have attached information from our last year's clean-up effort which averaged nearly 400,000 pounds. This event has been very well received over the past years but we feel each neighborhood needs to be familiar with other programs we wish to offer, such as litter reduction and ways to improve recycling. We do understand that this is a continuous effort, and raising awareness to keep our community free from trash and unwanted debris in the neighborhoods, businesses and our Olde Towne area, is where we wish to start.

Our first step is in the Olde Towne area, which is the heart of our City. We are asking for your financial assistance to help us purchase 8 garbage cans, which we feel will help in both litter control and add to the esthetics in our Main Street area. In order for us to purchase the specific garbage receptacles we wish to apply for \$2,400.00. Our Public Works Department will handle daily monitoring to empty, which will help us to monitor our year in totals. We are sure this will aid in keeping our Olde Towne area cleaner and safer with the esthetics these receptacles will serve.

Purchase of the receptacles will take place 2 weeks after grant has been awarded.

We are also asking for your assistance in purchasing twenty "Keep Clinton Beautiful" signs to post throughout our City. Cost for these 18" x 20" signs will cost \$840.00, and will increase awareness.

Purchase of these signs will take place 2 weeks after grant has been awarded.
