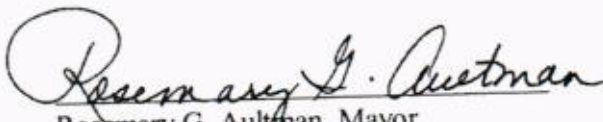

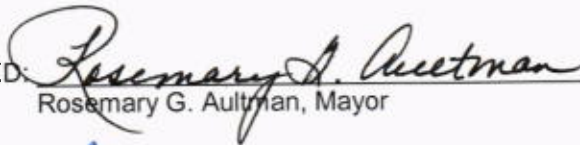
Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
