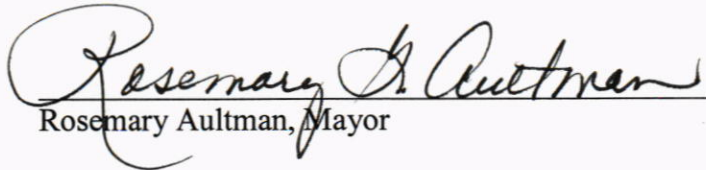

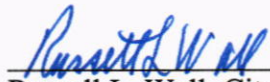
WHEREAS, the strategies of this plan are to identify and characterize hazards, assess risk, prioritize and implement mitigation measures; and,

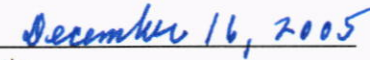
WHEREAS, the adoption of the Clinton Hazard Mitigation Plan would be in the best interest and protection of the citizens of the City of Clinton.
