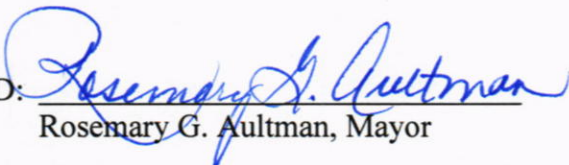
APPROVAL OF PROCLAMATION OF EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

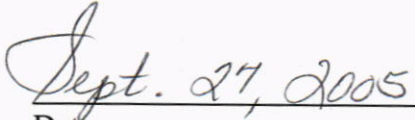


**NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING OF
