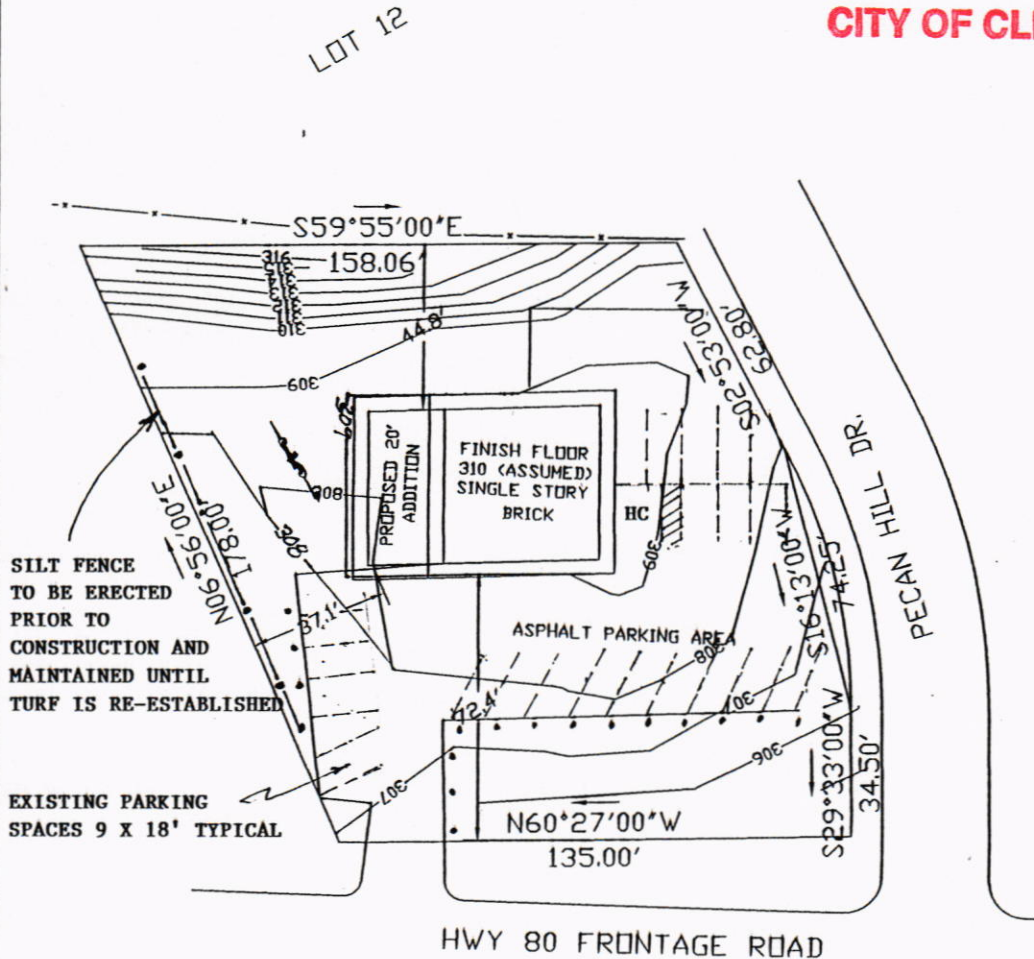

Ladies and Gentlemen:

We recently began the purchasing process of a lot on Spring Ridge Road, specifically the lot located @ 610 Spring Ridge road and parcel number 2862-164-9. We were informed that a church would fall into the classification requiring a Conditional Use Permit for a public/ quasi-public facility.

Included in this submission is the Request for Rezoning Application provided by the Planning and Zoning Department, a check for \$250 dollars, the names and address of the owners of all the property within 165 feet of the building site and a site plan that demonstrates the setbacks and how we anticipate utilizing the property.

It is our plan to build a building that will serve as a Church. 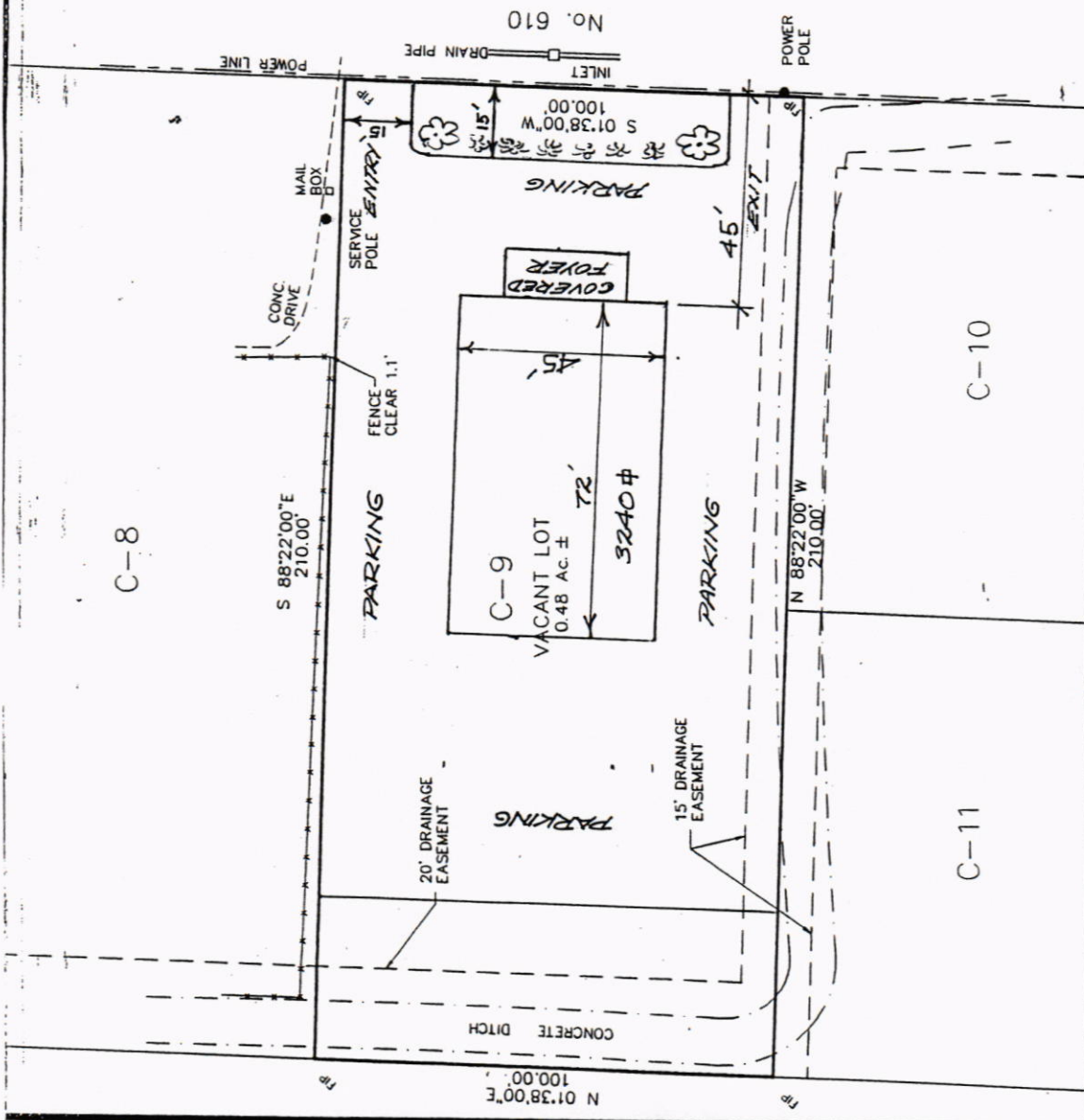

**RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONDITIONAL USE FOR
PUBLIC/PUBLIC-QUASI FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 610 SPRINGRIDGE ROAD,
CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI**

WHEREAS, New Birth Pentecostal Church, did file a request for a designation of the property located at 610 Springridge Road as a public/quasi-public facility; and,

WHEREAS, all notice requirements of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Clinton were accomplished and a public hearing was held on November 25, 2003, as required; and,

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission upon conclusion of the public hearing on November 25, 2003, adopted a motion to approve the request for a public/quasi-public facility and that the motion be forwarded to the next meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen for their consideration.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Clinton, Mississippi, have the final authority with regard to all matters involving the Zoning Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen are fully familiar with the request and the area involved in the request; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Clinton, Mississippi that the request of New Birth Pentecostal Church for designation of the property located at 610 Springridge Road as a public/public-quasi facility and hereby granted and such action is taken pursuant to the findings of fact set out as follows:

1. The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Clinton, Mississippi, have the final authority with regard to all matters involving the Zoning Ordinance.
2. The recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission is advisory in nature.
3. The Mayor and Board of Aldermen have knowledge of the area involved and are aware of the need for the conditional use.
4. The requested designation meets the definitions of a Conditional Use of the Zoning Ordinance.
5. The Conditional-Use will promote the general welfare of the City of Clinton and will not adversely affect adjacent property. Future projects within the designation area will remain subject to the Zoning Ordinance and approval of site plans or other matter will allow the City to continue to monitor the area.
6. The Mayor and Board of Aldermen find that Section 402 of the Zoning Ordinances has been complied with and that the requirements of Section 2405.01 of the Zoning Ordinances are satisfied based upon the presentation of the applicants and the site plan presented to the Planning Commission and to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.

7. The granting of this conditional-use does not relieve the requested from compliance with any applicable law, court order, covenants or contracts.

As requested, I have personally studied appropriate data pertinent to arriving at a "Market Value Estimate" of the real property referenced above. I have personally inspected the property. The site has no improvements.

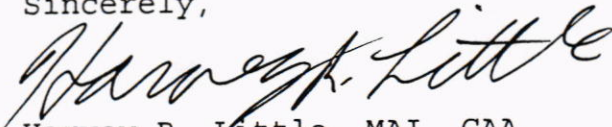
