NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN

I, the undersigned, Mayor Rosemary G. Aultman, Mayor of the City of Clinton, Mississippi, do hereby call a SPECIAL MEETING of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen pursuant to the provisions of Section 21-3-21 of the Mississippi Code of 1972. Said Meeting shall be held at 5:30 p.m., Friday, October 19, 2001, in the Conference Room located at 300 Jefferson Street, for the purpose of discussing the following item:

1. Discussion/Action – Adoption of Resolution for Renewal Community certification for designated portions of the City of Clinton

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI recognizes the need for economic development and deems such a priority in this community; and,

WHEREAS, a Renewal Community Designation is being sought from the Governor of the State of Mississippi; and,

WHEREAS, a Certification is required to ensure that certain Economic Growth Promotion regulations be adopted by the CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI to allow inclusion into the Renewal Community designation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI does certify that:

1. ROSEMARY AULTMAN, as MAYOR of the CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI, is the authorized signatory for the CITY, and is empowered to execute any and all documents, certifications and forms necessary for the Renewal Community application.
2. The CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI intends to, at least for the period the CITY is part of the Renewal Community, and to the extent allowed by the applicable laws of the State of Mississippi, address the following areas of concern by the actions described below.

A. AREA OF CONCERN: Licensing requirements for occupations that do not ordinarily require a professional degree.

ACTION: For such occupations the CITY will not require additional licensing requirements for occupations that do not ordinarily require a professional degree, other than those imposed by the state law unless necessary for the protection of the health and safety of the community and its inhabitants.

B. AREA OF CONCERN: Permit requirements for street vendors who do not create a public nuisance.

ACTION: The CITY will not place additional permit requirements for street vendors who do not create any kind of a public nuisance other than those imposed by state statute on the governing authorities, unless necessary for the protection of the health and safety of the community and its inhabitants.

C. AREA OF CONCERN: Zoning or other restrictions that impede the formation of schools or childcare centers.

ACTION: The CITY will consider placing no additional zoning or undue restrictions on the formation of schools or childcare centers unless they create any type of public nuisance.

D. AREA OF CONCERN: Excessive franchises or other undue restrictions on competition for businesses providing jitneys.

ACTION: No exclusive franchises or other undue restrictions on competition for businesses providing jitneys will be awarded or enacted in the future.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the MAYOR OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI, does hereby authorize:

1. That the CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI be included into the Renewal Community designation.
2. The Central Mississippi Planning and Development District be designated as the Coordinating Responsible Agency (CoRA) on behalf of the CITY and the Renewal Community should the designation be approved.
