ENGINEERING INTERN

NATURE OF WORK

This is a highly responsible administrative, professional and technical work in assisting the City Engineer. This person must exercise considerable independent judgment and discretion in carrying out the responsibilities. This person works under general supervision of the City Engineer.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK
