BID AWARDED TO FOUNTAIN CONSTRUCTION FOR HWY 80/LAKEVIEW SIGNAL MODIFICATIONS

DRAINAGE CORRECTION ON ROCKINGHAM DRIVE

MOTION made by Alderman Brabham and SECONDED by Alderman Todd after conducting a visual inspection and subsequent investigation of the storm drainage system problem on Rockingham Drive on which no recorded easement can be found, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, upon consultation and professional advice from the City Engineer have determined that the deterioration of storm drainage pipe is causing a possible public safety hazard. Based on the analysis of the City Engineer, and supportive opinion of the Mayor and board of Aldermen, that unless this problem is corrected, the situation will continue to escalate causing additional damage adversely affecting public health and safety. It is therefore recommended that the City of Clinton include this project on our street drainage project worklist and proceed in a timely and orderly manner to acquire the proper rights of entry and release of damages from the property owners so that the necessary work can be implemented to correct this drainage problem. 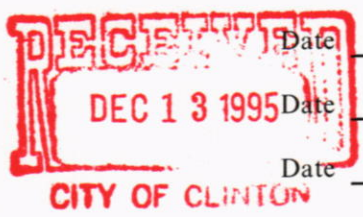

The Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Clinton, Mississippi, will receive sealed BIDS for the construction of the United Artists Street and Utility Improvements, no later than 10:00 AM, Local Time, on the 28 Day of Dec., 1995, at the Board Room, City Hall, 300 Jefferson Street, P.O. Box 156, Clinton, Mississippi 39060. All bids so received will be publicly opened and read aloud.
The CONTRACT DOCUMENTS may be examined at the following locations:

2. Alford Engineering, 5135 Galaxie Drive, Suite 401D, Jackson, Mississippi 39206
All documents required for bidding purposes, including plans and specifications, may be obtained from Alford Engineering located at 5135 Galaxie Drive, Suite 401D, Jackson, Mississippi 39206 upon payment of \$100.00 for each set.
Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check on a solvent bank or a BIDDER's Bond issued by a Surety Company licensed to operate in the State of Mississippi, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid price, as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, the BIDDER will enter into a contract and execute the Performance and Payment Bonds in the form and within the time specified.
The successful BIDDER will be required to execute a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent (100%) of the Contract, issued by a Surety Company licensed to operate in the State of Mississippi.
Each BIDDER shall have a Certificate of Responsibility to bid on contracts for public projects in which the bid price exceeds \$50,000.00 and for private projects in which the bid price exceeds \$100,000.00 as required by the laws of the State of Mississippi. Each BIDDER shall show on the outside of the envelope containing his bid; his current Certificate of Responsibility number and expiration date, or if applicable, a statement certifying that the bid enclosed does not exceed \$50,000.00 for a public project or \$100,000.00 for a private project; his name; and the name of the Contract for which the bid is submitted. Failure to show these items on the outside of the envelope containing the bid will result in the bid being returned to the BIDDER unopened. Public funds are involved in this project.
No BIDDER may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days after date of actual opening, without Owner's consent.
The City of Clinton, Mississippi reserves the right to reject any or all bids received, to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids received, and to accept any bid which is deemed most favorable to the City.

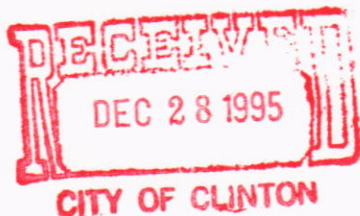
