MOTION made by Alderman Ferrell and **SECONDED** by Alderman Lott to approve Consent Agenda Items A-00 excluding item M as listed on pages 57-58 of this Minute Book W, noting that Consent Agenda Item G, will serve to advertise favorably the opportunities, possibilities, and resources of the City of Clinton. RE-ZONING OF MURRIEL PROPERTY ON TINNIN/KELLEY ROAD GRANTED

Following comments from Attorney Bill Johnson representing Mr. and Mrs. Graves who live out of town but own adjacent property to Virgil Murriel who has come before the City of Clinton Planning and Zoning Board and the Mayor and Board of Aldermen on two separate occasions requesting a re-zoning of her property on the corner of Tinnin/Kelly Roads from R-1 to C-1 for the purpose of opening a beauty shop, **MOTION** made by Alderman Ferrell and **SECONDED** by Alderman Fisher to grant that request of Virgil Murriel to rezone said property from R-1 to C-1. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.** Proof of proper public hearing may be found on page 1175 of Minute Book V. SITE REVIEW FOR FIRST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH PARKING LOT APPROVED

Mr. Roger Foster of Foster, Jones & Associates presented a site plan review for the parking lot on the southwest intersection of Stonegate Drive and Highway 80 for Clinton's First United Methodist Church. MOTION made by Alderman Fisher and SECONDED by Alderman Touchton to approve said site plan review. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

AMENDMENT TO CITY BEER ORDINANCE DIES FOR LACK OF MOTION

The issue of amending the current City Ordinance regulating the sale of beer in the City of Clinton to allow beer and light wine sales by the drink in local restaurants died for lack of a motion.

Mayor Aultman stated that this was a far-reaching issue which should be addressed completely before Board action but she did allow people to comment on the issue limiting their comments to two minutes each. In addition to comments made from the Mayor and Board of Aldermen individually, the following citizens publicly spoke against allowing beer to be sold by the drink in local restaurants: Mr. Dickey King, 504 Hollyberry Drive; Mr. Tommy Snyder, 225 Hood Drive; Mr. Randy Riley, 200 Morrison Drive; Dr. Owens Palmertree, 4 Highland Square; and Mr. Paul Jones, 3 Dove Way Circle. Mr. James Conerly, 302 Longwood Drive, spoke both "for and against" said issue. Mr. Raman Patel, 403 Parker Drive asked everyone to think about the fact that a restaurant could open up and sell hard liquor or wine by the drink and not sell beer.

NO BOARD ACTION was taken. Alderman Ferrell left the Board Room at 7:37 p.m. At present the City Beer Ordinance Regulating the Sale of Beer stands as is with beer being sold in convenience stores and grocery stores but can not be sold by the drink in restaurants.

FINAL PLAT FOR DEHMER DEVELOPMENT APPROVED

Upon request of Public Works Director Alderman to approve the Final Plat of the Joe T. Dehmer Commercial Development, Phase I, Part 2 on the southwest corner of I-20/Springridge Road, MOTION made by Alderman Touchton and SECONDED by Alderman DePriest to approve said final plat. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Alderman Ferrell not present for voting.

MAYOR NAMED VOTING REPRESENTATIVE ON BOARD FOR CENTRAL SOUTHWEST MISSISSIPPI SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY

MOTION made by Alderman Lott and SECONDED by Alderman Todd nominating Mayor Rosemary Aultman, ex-officio, to serve as the City's voting representative on the Board of Commissioners of the Central Southwest Mississippi Solid Waste Management Authority. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Alderman Ferrell not present for voting.

AUTHORIZATION TO SEEK PROPOSALS FOR CITY FLAG AND CREST

MOTION made by Alderman Touchton and SECONDED by Alderman Fisher authorizing Mayor Aultman to begin seeking proposals for the development of a City of Clinton Flag and Crest to be used to promote the City of Clinton. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Alderman Ferrell not present for voting.

QUIT CLAIM DEED GIVEN TO JAMES B. AND PHYLLIS B. HURLEY

MOTION made by Alderman DePriest and SECONDED by Alderman Fisher authorizing that Quit Claim Deed found on pages 60-61 of this Minute Book W removing cloud on title of property shown on said deed owned by James B. and Phyllis B. Hurley. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Alderman Ferrell not present for voting.

ADJUSTMENT OF MAXIMUM UPSET FEE FOR TRACEWAY PARK CONSTRUCTION AUTHORIZED FOR WEATHERFORD-MCDADE, LTD.

Upon recommendation by City Engineer Broome to increase the maximum upset fee to Weatherford-McDade, Ltd., for Traceway Park Construction from the original fee of \$9,0009.00 to \$13,259.00, for additional necessary work as shown on the letter found on pages 62-63 of this Minute Book W, MOTION made by Alderman DePriest and SECONDED by Alderman Todd to approve said fee. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Alderman Ferrell not present for voting. Alderman DePriest reiterated that he would like for our new full-time City Engineer and Engineering Technician to be involved in the rough grade administration of projects to reduce the contract engineering fees as much as possible.

AUTHORIZATION FOR SPRINGRIDGE ROAD PROJECT EASEMENTS AND ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

City Engineer Broome apprised the Board that in conjunction with the FAUS Springridge Road Widening Project that the City of Clinton will have to do some additional drainage work on the south end of said project which will require obtaining the easements shown on page 64 of this Minute Book W. Broome then requested the Board to authorize him to make an offer to said necessary parties at the stated appraised amounts on page 64 of this Minute Book W, and also authorize him to finalize plans and advertise for bids noting that bid to contractor will not be awarded until after all necessary easements are secured. MOTION made by Alderman Touchton and SECONDED by Alderman Todd to authorize procurement of said easements and authority to advertise for bids. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Alderman Ferrell not present for voting.

ADDITIONAL STEPS ADDED TO PROFESSIONAL & MANAGERIAL PAY SCALE TO ALLOW COMPENSATION FOR FULL-TIME CITY ENGINEER

MOTION made by Alderman Fisher and SECONDED by Alderman Lott authorizing the additional steps #14-19 as shown on page 65-66 of this Minute Book W to be added to the Professional and Managerial Pay Scale to allow compensation for the new full-time City Engineer who will be placed at Step 18-3 effective July 21, 1993. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Alderman Ferrell not present for voting.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE ORDAINING RULES, RATES, AND REGULATIONS OF WATERWORKS - INCREASING WATER/SEWER RATES 20%

Due to the cash deficit situation in the City of Clinton Waterworks Department for the past year and noting the present water rates are insufficient to keep the water fund solvent and pay future bills, MOTION made by Alderman Brabham and SECONDED by Alderman Todd to adopt that ordinance found on pages 67-68 of this Minute Book W and on pages 545-546 of the City of Clinton Ordinance Book II increasing water and sewer rates 20% effective 30 days from passage. MOTION CARRIED 5-1 with Alderman Fisher casting the "nay" vote and Alderman Ferrell not present for voting. Proof of Publication that said ordinance was properly published may be found on page 69 and 547 of this Minute Book W and the City of Clinton Ordinance Book II respectively.

CITY ATTORNEY APPOINTMENT ANNOUNCED

Mayor Aultman announced that in a Special Called Meeting Monday, August 2, 1993, 4:30 p.m., the Board of Aldermen appointed Pyle, Dreher, Mills & Dye as the new City Attorney Firm with Mr. Ken Dreher acting as principal attorney, and that Bill Spell will continue as the City Prosecutor until the Board addresses that position. Dear Richard,

As we had discussed last week, it appears that we will exceed the original fee amount established by the Board for construction administration services at Traceway Park.

Please remember that the quotation originally given to you was relative to providing stake out and administrative services on behalf of the City to the Hinds County forces which would be providing rough grading services at Traceway Park.

Upon our review of the documents, several questions regarding elements of the proposed park plans were brought to your's and Mr. Arledge's attention, to which we were instructed to further study and make recommendations. These recommendations have been presented to you, Mr. Arledge, and the Mayor in a rough draft form. Final recommendations including cost estimates are to be presented to the Board at their August 2 workshop, and the cost estimate will be ready for distribution to the Board by July 28. To minimize additional time delays, we were to proceed as directed charging time for these services to the construction administration agreement.

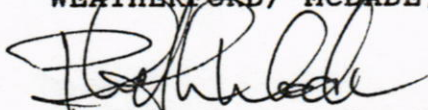
Recently, two items have added to this problem. Electronic base map information was not available for us to perform earthwork calculations by computer, necessitating hand drawn preparation of the earthwork sections. Additionally, the surveyor was needed to locate the existing water main on the existing drawings once it had been marked in the field by City forces.

We request that our maximum upset fee of \$9009.00 be increased by \$4,250.00 to a new total of \$13,259.00 to provide compensation for services required as noted above. Pending a decision by the Board on August 3, 1993, we believe work on this phase of the project will be considered as complete.

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If this is acceptable to both you and Mr. Arledge, we request that both of you sign and return this letter at your earliest convenience. Should you have any questions or comments, please advise.
