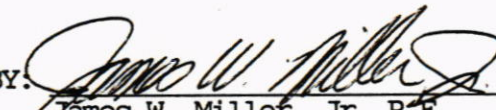

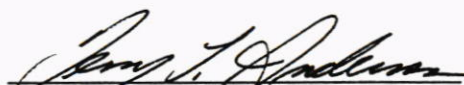

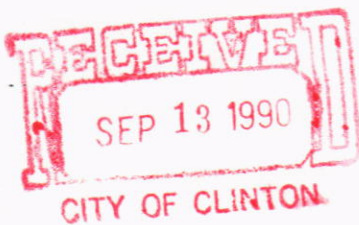

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CLINTON FINALLY DISPOSING CHARGEBACK ON HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION FOR THE YEAR 1989 MADE BY THE STATE TAX COMMISSION
