Upon the recommendation of Mayor Smith, MOTION made by Alderman Valente and SECONDED by Alderman Montgomery to appoint Mr. Bill Lovelady, Jr., to serve on the City of Clinton Parks & Recreation Board with said term of office expiring 1-1-94. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

PROGRESS REPORT GIVEN BY ARCHITECT AL USRY ON NEW POLICE FACILITY

Architect Al Usry, presented a proposed site plan and progress report for the new police facility with NO BOARD ACTION being taken. In addition to discussion of buildings, liability, parking and zoning, it was decided to include the removal of the two large pecan trees on said site by the contractor in with the demolition of the Street and Clark houses. AUTHORIZATION TO SECURE AND ACCEPT EASEMENTS TO CORRECT HICKORY LANE DRAINAGE PROBLEM

PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR DIRECTED TO BRING RECOMMENDATION AND COST FIGURES TO NEXT BOARD MEETING FOR CLINTON-RAYMOND/BANKS ROAD DRAINAGE PROBLEM

Following preliminary remarks regarding that drainage problem that begins at Trailwood-Countrywood, Olde Vineyard flowing across Clinton-

Raymond Road and extending to Banks Road, MOTION made by Alderman Ferrell and SECONDED by Alderman Valente to authorize the Public Works Department to proceed with said project using either Soil Conservation Service Funds or, if approved, City Storm Drainage Funds and to obtain the necessary easements.

Prior to a vote, discussion was then held on cost figure options and other drainage projects already considered and included in the budgetary process. MOTION was then made by Alderman Valente and SECONDED by Alderman Ferrell to amend the motion to ask the Public Works Director to recommend the correction, what easements are necessary and the cost associated with the correction of this problem so appropriate funds can be allocated as expediently as possible prior to beginning work on said projects and the budget modified to cover the cost. AMENDMENT TO THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY and MOTION-AS-AMENDED CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY. It was noted that City Attorney Spell stated that projects should not be approved unless the money has been budgeted and funds are available for said project requested.

Mayor Smith to call a working meeting within the next month and to notify the citizens of Clinton and City Department Heads for the purpose of discussing the policy to be adhered to for drainage issues and for accepting easements.

ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL ORDINANCE, ZONING ORDINANCE, AND ZONING MAP TO BE DISCUSSED AT NEXT BOARD MEETING

Proposals for an Architectural Control Ordinance written by Weatherford-McDade, Ltd.; and a City of Clinton Zoning Ordinance and Zoning Map prepared by CMPDD as recommended by the Planning and Zoning Board will be discussed at the next Board Meeting following presentations of same made by Mr. Dwight Weatherford of Weatherford-McDade, Ltd. and Mr. Larry Smith of CMPDD. NO BOARD ACTION taken.

MOTION TO DISMISS ANDERSON ENGINEERS AS CITY ENGINEER FAILED

Following comments made by Alderman-at-Large Ryan in which he stated due to the fact that "he did not believe the people of this City want a City Engineer whose peers, responsible for engineering ethics and acting as a state agency, have found said City Engineer guilty of ethics violations and placed him on probation", Alderman Ryan then MOVED to dismiss mr. Anderson (Anderson Engineers) as City Engineer. Mayor Smith calling twice for a second and receiving none, said motion DIED FOR LACK OF SECOND.

AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE CHAMBER BANQUET TICKETS FOR VOLUNTEER BOARDS

Acting upon the request of Mayor Smith to purchase 1991 Chamber of Commerce Banquet Tickets for those volunteer members of the City of Clinton Planning and Zoning Board, Parks & Recreation Board, Library Board and Election Commission not to exceed 22 tickets @ \$15.00 each, MOTION made by Alderman Montgomery and SECONDED by Alderman Lott to purchase said tickets. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

PUBLIC HEARING ANNOUNCEMENT - HINDS COUNTY JAIL

Mayor Smith announced that the Hinds County Board of Supervisors will hold a Public Hearing on January 17, 1991, 7 P.M., at the Raymond Courthouse to discuss the location and impact of a new Hinds County Jail Facility. NO BOARD ACTION.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO STUDY DRAINAGE AND CAVE-IN PROBLEM AT 106 SAN CARLOS

MOTION made by Alderman Ferrell to direct the Public Works Department to proceed obtaining easements and to do whatever it takes to correct the drainage and cave-in problem at 106 San Carlos. Following further discussion of said problem wherein underground waterflow is causing cave-ins, Alderman Ferrell withdrew his motion and Public Works Director Alderman was directed to study said problem and determine if it can be solved with Public Works Department crews and equipment. NO BOARD ACTION.

BOARD TO STUDY OPTIONS AT NEXT MEETING OF RELOCATING/IMPROVING SOUTHWEST LAGOON

MOTION made by Alderman Johnson and SECONDED by Alderman Valente to study the matter of relocating or improving the Southwest Lagoon at its present site at the next Board Meeting. ROLL CALL VOTE: Alderman Ryan - "nay", Alderman Ferrell - "aye", Alderman Valente - "aye", Alderman Chappell - "nay", Alderman Montgomery - "aye", Alderman Johnson - "aye", Alderman Lott - "nay". MOTION CARRIED 4-3. It was noted by City Engineer Anderson that construction must be underway on said project by April 1, 1991, with a one-year completion deadline. City Attorney Spell was directed to keep both options open for land acquisition (the land necessary to relocate and also the land necessary for upgrading at present site) until further direction at the next Board Meeting.
